August has been a busy month for me personally. Melanie and I worked with Group Creative Services and the Waveland Park Neighborhood Association to build and deliver several "Wonder Boxes" as part a neighborhood wide "Wonder Week: event.

The Wonder Boxes take a number of forms and are designed to share and distribute art, sculpture, photography, toys, puzzles, and games. "That's nice," you're probably thinking, "but what does this have to do with orchids?"

Pictured to the left is the box Melanie and I made for our own yard. It's garden and plant themed and we've been using it to share seedlings and plants - including orchids. So far we've had a lot of traffic and we plan on leveraging that engagement to share not just plants but information.

Going forward when we put orchids in the box for sharing, we'll include basic care information, including a QR code linking to aos.org website culture data, and information about the CIOS. The August meeting of the Central Iowa Orchid Society was called to order by President Brian Johnson. The Secretary's report was read and approved. The Treasurer's report was read by Brian. Expenses for Speaker's Day were given - \$423.43 to Jenny Howell. \$803.11 to Eric Sauer, \$1110.33 to Frank Cervera, \$640.66 to Maria Fedorova, \$50.00 to the Chicago Judging Center. \$440.69 to Ardie Strawman. Income was \$347.00 in door prize tickets, plus \$1210.00 that needs some further explaining. The balance in our checking account is \$6386.47 plus the CD of \$5300. Doc Bannister requested a tax donation for the monthly data plan charges. A motion was made, seconded, and approved for this. We delayed approval of the Treasurer's report until we get further clarification on the Speaker's Day income.

President's Report - Brian announced that the July newsletter was emailed to members. He welcomes photos and/or stories about members' orchids for future newsletters.

The meeting was adjourned.

Membership

The Central Iowa Orchid Society (CIOS) was organized in 1961. It is a nonprofit social club. Membership in the CIOS also includes membership in the Mid-America Orchid Congress.

Yearly dues are \$15 for an individual or \$25 for a family. New members joining after July 1st are only required to pay one-half the annual membership fee - \$7 for an individual or \$12 for a family. Membership can be renewed starting in November and dues become delinquent after the February meeting. Members will be dropped from the roll if dues have not been paid in six months.

Meetings are generally held on the first Sunday of every month at the Union Park Methodist Church, East 12th & Guthrie, Des Moines and begin at 2:00 pm.

Among the advantages of membership in CIOS are a large library of orchid literature, programs, displays and discussions on blooming plants, helpful advice, door prizes, and friendly socializing about orchids.
